This skill set is the perfect start to the civil construction with employment prospects in the building of major infrastructure projects including road, rail (METRONET), and waterways.

You will gain an introduction to working in Civil Construction and learn to:

- Work safely at heights
- Apply work, health and safety requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry
- Carry out simple concreting and rendering, and install trench support
- Work safely on roofs, erect and dismantle scaffolding and operate elevated work platforms up to 11 metres
- Carry out levelling operations
- Operate small plant and equipment

You'll be job ready to join a building team or work as a trade assistant (TA) in bricklaying, carpentry, electrical or plumbing.



If you're aged 15–24 years (not at school), receiving the JobSeeker or JobKeeper payment, receiving Youth Allowance, AUSTUDY or ABSTUDY or holding a pensioner concession card, Health Care Card or a Repatriation Health Benefits Card issued by the Department of Veterans' Affairs, or a dependent of persons who are inmates of a custodial institution, you are eligible to enrol for free!

Fees and charges

Local full time students

Course fees are made up of two components, tuition fees and resource fees.
