This course includes a non-assessed work experience placement in an Aboriginal kindy and a practicum in a childcare centre.

You will need to obtain a **Working with Children Check** card.

### Typical timetable

- Orientation - 9:30am - 12:00pm, Thursday 17 October 2019
- Followed by 2 weeks work experience placement in an Aboriginal kindy (non-assessed) - 8:30am - 3:00pm, Tuesdays - Thursdays
- Then classes run for 3 weeks - 9:30am - 2:30pm, Tuesdays - Thursdays
- Followed by a one week practicum in a childcare centre - 9:00am - 5:30pm, Monday - Friday
