



# 52528WA Course in Gaining Access to Training and Employment (GATE Introductory)

## For people with an intellectual or learning disability

### Duration

Six month (two terms), two days per week, 9:00am - 1:30pm

### Location

North Metropolitan TAFE, Joondalup campus  
35 Kendrew Crescent, Joondalup

### Description

This course will assist learners with an intellectual disability to articulate into vocational pathways and to develop the skills and abilities to direct their own progress. The course is designed for a cohort of young adults that are approximately 18 to 28 years of age.

### Entrance requirements

There are no formal entry requirements. However, students need to be able to read, write and use a computer at a basic level, as well as demonstrate behaviour appropriate to an adult learning environment.

Parents /carers must attend an interview with the student to assess student suitability.

Students may be required to bring a support worker to class depending on their needs.

Please note that due to limited class sizes, meeting entrance requirements and attending an interview does not guarantee applicants a place in this course.

### How to apply
