



52769WA Certificate I in Gaining Access to Training and Employment (GATE)

For people with an intellectual or learning disability

Duration

This course runs for two semesters (12 months). Students will attend the Joondalup (Kendrew) campus two days per week.

Location

North Metropolitan TAFE, Joondalup campus,
35 Kendrew Crescent, Joondalup

Description

This course will assist people with an intellectual disability to articulate into vocational pathways and to develop the skills and abilities to direct their own progress. The course is designed for young adults that are approximately 18 to 28 years of age.

Students will need to enrol each semester.

Entrance requirements

There are no formal entry requirements however, students and parents/carers must attend an interview to assess student suitability.

Students may be required to bring a support workers to class depending on their needs.

How to apply

Selection is by interview, which may include an academic assessment.

Interviews for classes and courses starting in February 2021 will take place in C Block Joondalup campus (Kendrew Crescent) from 1 December to 8 December 2020. You will need to attend only one (1) interview, even if you are interested in more than one course.
