



# 22301VIC Certificate I in Transition Education

## For people with an intellectual or learning disability

### Duration

This is a full-time course run over two semesters. Part time enrolment for this course may be an option, if places are available.

Students will attend North Metro TAFE, Leederville campus for four days per week.

### Description

The Certificate I in Transition Education is a vocational course developed specifically to train students who have intellectual or learning disabilities, wishing to explore a range of post school options that may include employment and further study. There is no work experience component in this course.

- VU21046 Prepare simple budgets

**Students will need to enrol each semester.**

### Entrance requirements

Students must:

- Be personally motivated to attend and actively participate with other students in the class
- Demonstrate behaviour appropriate to an adult learning environment
- Have appropriate literacy, numeracy skills to manage course content
- Be able to travel using public transport, and mobility to access a range of community services and facilities.

Please note that due to limited class sizes, meeting entrance requirements does not guarantee applicants a place in this course.

Selection is by interview, which may also include an academic assessment.
