



# 22471VIC Course in Initial General Education for Adults

## For people with an intellectual or learning disability

### Duration

This is a 1 year part-time course, with part-time enrolment available subject to vacancies.

Students will attend North Metro TAFE, Joondalup campus for one day per week.

### Description

This course is specifically for students who have intellectual disabilities and aims to improve student literacy and numeracy skills. There is a focus on specific literacy and numeracy skills that develop independence to participate in work and community living.

### Entrance requirements

Students must:

- Be personally motivated to attend and actively participate with other students in the class
- Demonstrate behaviour appropriate to an adult learning environment
- Have appropriate literacy, numeracy skills to manage course content
- Be able to travel using public transport, and mobility to access a range of community services and facilities.

Please note that due to limited class sizes, meeting entrance requirements does not guarantee applicants a place in this course.
