Our courses are taught by experienced lecturers who work closely with specialist employment agencies to explore work outcomes and prepare students for the world of work.

Depending which course you study you'll have access to modern facilities including practice workplaces such as office, café and retail spaces, computer labs and horticulture areas. Classes are smaller than average to ensure a quality student journey for all.

Extra support for student success such as workplace literacy and numeracy, job seeking skills and study support are supplied.
