## 52768WA Course in Gaining Access to Training and Employment (GATE) (Introductory)

For people with an intellectual or learning disability

### Duration

This is a one semester full-time course at Leederville campus. Classes run three days per week.

### Description

This is a vocational course developed specifically to provide students with intellectual or learning disabilities with the skills needed to access and maintain employment in the horticulture industry.

The course involves both theory and practical elements and student have the opportunity to work in a garden on site at Leederville campus.

### Entrance requirements

Students must:

- Be personally motivated to attend and actively participate with other students in the class.
- Demonstrate behaviour appropriate to an adult learning environment.
- Have sufficient literacy and numeracy skills to cope with course content and workplace requirements.
- Be able to demonstrate an interest and aptitude for horticulture.
