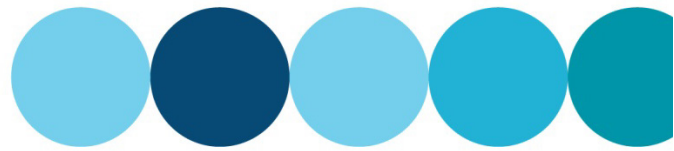


Upcoming work

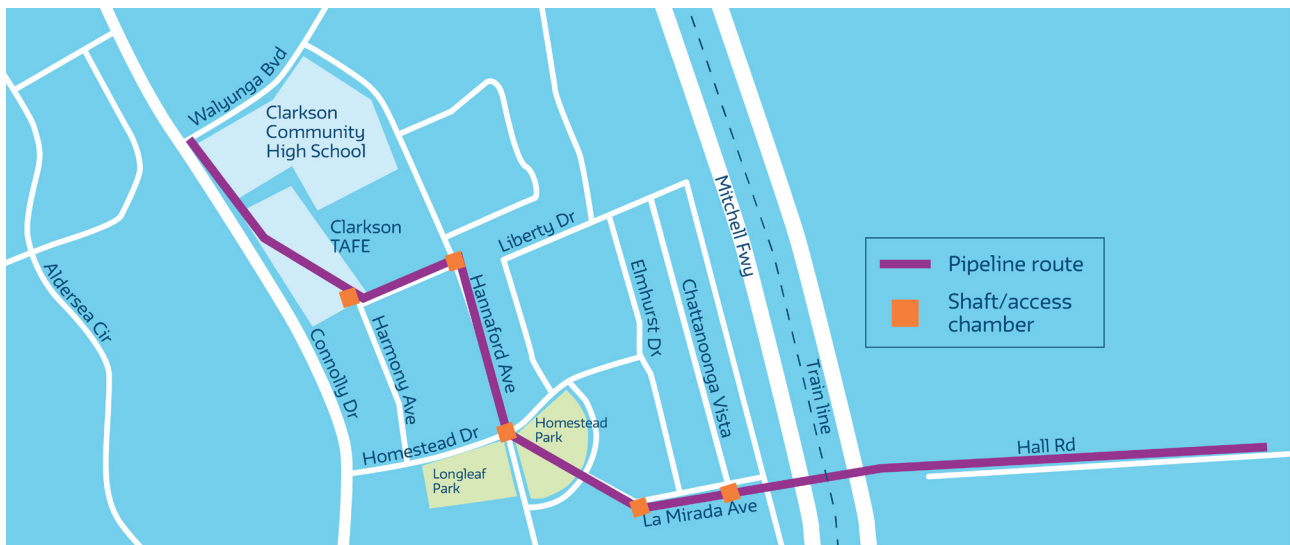

What is happening?

Water Corporation's authorised contractor, Rob Carr, will construct 1.9 kilometres of wastewater pipeline. This work will take place in sections along Connolly Drive, Hannaford Avenue, Harmony Avenue, Homestead Drive, La Mirada Avenue and Hall Road.

To enable construction, there will be eight shafts and access chambers built. The key ones are noted on the map below.



When is this happening?

Work will start on 7 February 2022 and continue for approximately 14 months. Most of the work will be undertaken Monday to Saturday, between 7am and 7pm.

How will this impact me?

Traffic

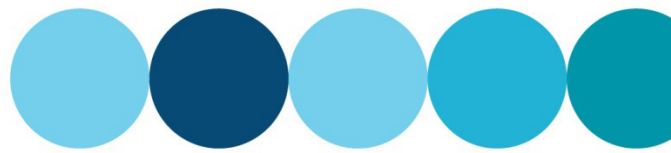
There will be road closures and traffic detours in place for lengthy periods of time. If you drive, you will not be able to enter the TAFE via Walunga Boulevard and Hannaford Avenue, as there will be a road closure at Hannaford and Harmony Avenues. Construction will be occurring in the rear carpark; however access will be maintained and a temporary carpark will be created.

Bus

Outside TAFE on Connolly Drive, bus stop ID 23917 where bus 484 stops will be moved. The PTA will create a temporary bus stop 130 metres south of its current position.

Noise

Along Connolly Drive, construction work will be done by an open trench method. Unfortunately, this work can be noisy and a little dusty, but noise will be kept to a minimum and we are committed to working with TAFE to minimise impacts.
