



Certificate I in Retail

SIR10116 | For people with an intellectual or learning disability

Duration

This is a 1 year full-time course, with part-time enrolment available subject to vacancies.

Students will attend Leederville Campus for two days per week and a structured work placement for 1 day per week in a retail workplace.

Description

This is a vocational course developed specifically to provide students with an intellectual or learning disability with the skills needed to access and maintain employment in the retail industry and develop basic barista skills. The college facilities include a well equipped practice shop.

Entrance requirements

Students must:

- Be personally motivated to attend and actively participate with other students in the class.
- Demonstrate behaviour appropriate to an adult learning environment.
- Have sufficient literacy skills to cope with course content and workplace requirements.
