



Certificate II in Horticulture

AHC20416 | For people with an intellectual or learning disability

Duration

This is a 1 year full-time course, with part-time enrolment available subject to vacancies.

Students will attend Leederville Campus for three days per week and a structured work placement for 1 day per week.

Description

This is a vocational course developed specifically to provide students with intellectual or learning disabilities with the skills needed to access and maintain employment in the horticulture industry.

Additional support is also provided including, Workplace Literacy and Numeracy, Workplace Requirements and tutorials.

Entrance requirements

Students must:

- Be personally motivated to attend and actively participate with other students in the class.
- Demonstrate behaviour appropriate to an adult learning environment.
- Have sufficient literacy and numeracy skills to cope with course content and workplace requirements.
- Be able to demonstrate an interest and aptitude for horticulture.

Selection is by personal interview, which will also include a literacy assessment.
