Duration

One year, part-time. Two days per week, 9:00am - 1:00pm (days to be confirmed)

Description

This course will assist learners with an intellectual disability to articulate into vocational pathways and to develop the skills and abilities to direct their own progress. The course is designed for a cohort of young adults that are approximately 18 to 28 years of age.

Entrance requirements

There are no formal entry requirements: However students and parents /carers must attend a face-to-face interview to assess student suitability. This course has been designed for young adults with intellectual disabilities. Students may be required to bring a support worker to class depending on their needs.
